- 3. Summarize the accomplishments of Ana Njinga. Why do you think her life story and accomplishments are not more readily known and taught in American schools?
- 4. Describe at least three ways that enslaved persons were tortured and dehumanized, beginning with the forced passage from their "home in Africa to the New World."
- 5. Describe at least three historic examples of ways that enslaved Africans and their descendants resisted their enslavement.
