Cultural landscape is the boundaries of a region that reflect the human imprint on the environment.

2) This building is an example of segment occupancy because the Jewish people who created the synagogue moved out, leaving their imprint on the area. When a new ethnic group moved in, it was repurposed for a church.

3) Relocation diffusion is when a culture is spread by people who carry their cultural traits with them when they migrate.

4) During the Great Migration African Americans moved out of the south into places like Bronzeville. They repurposed buildings left by other ethnic groups and imprinted their own culture.
