Mom: "You ain't getting none."

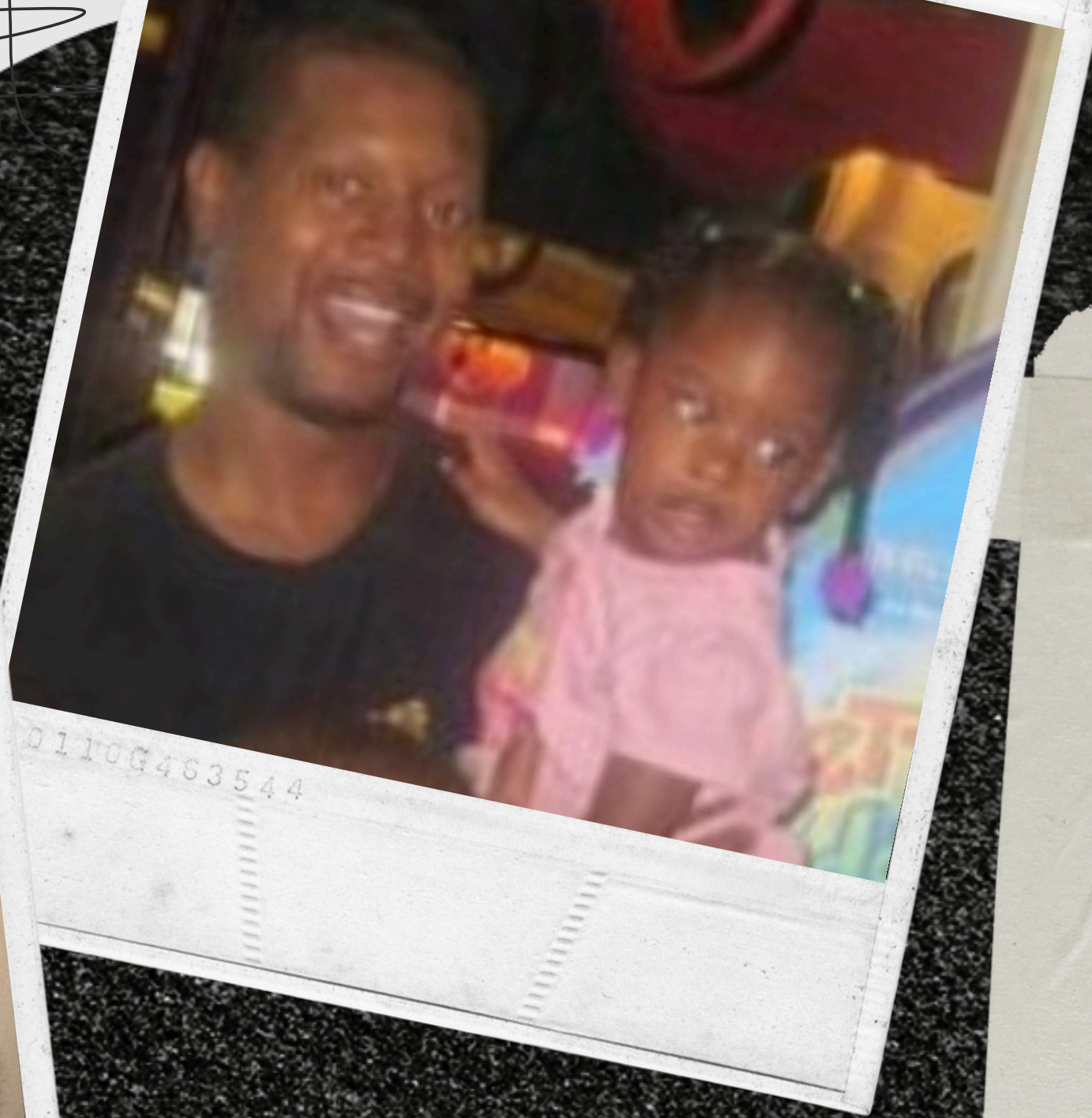
Mom: "Endy, the food's ready."

"Mommy, let's make cookies."





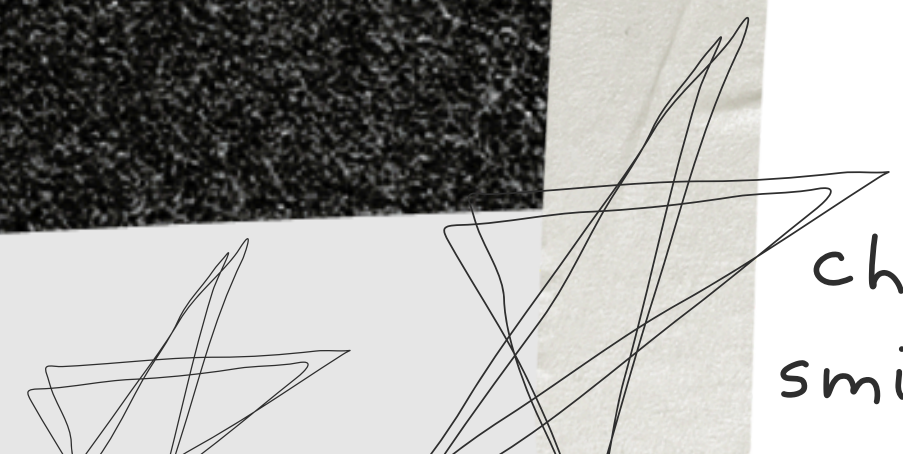
