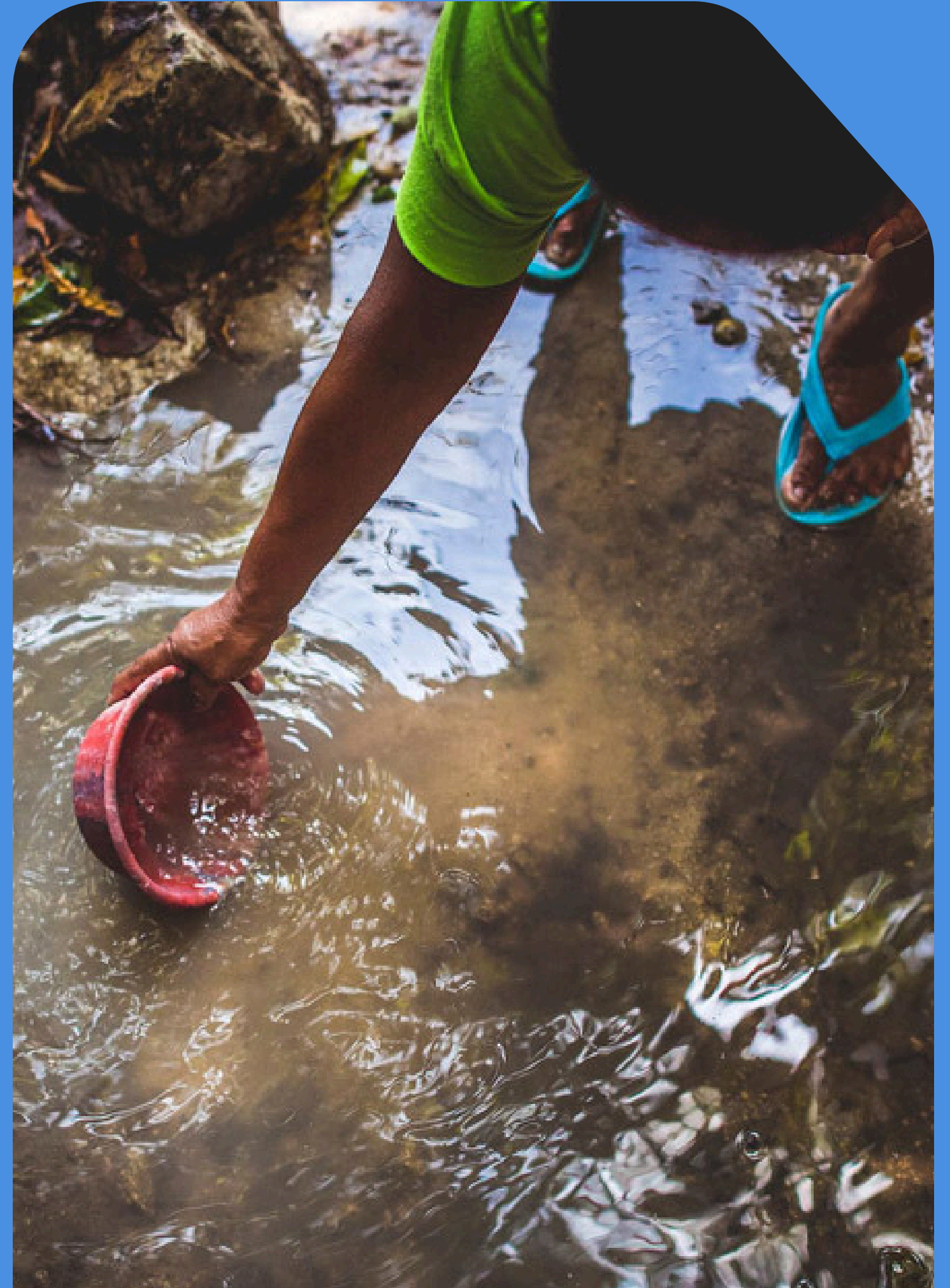

Access to clean water matters



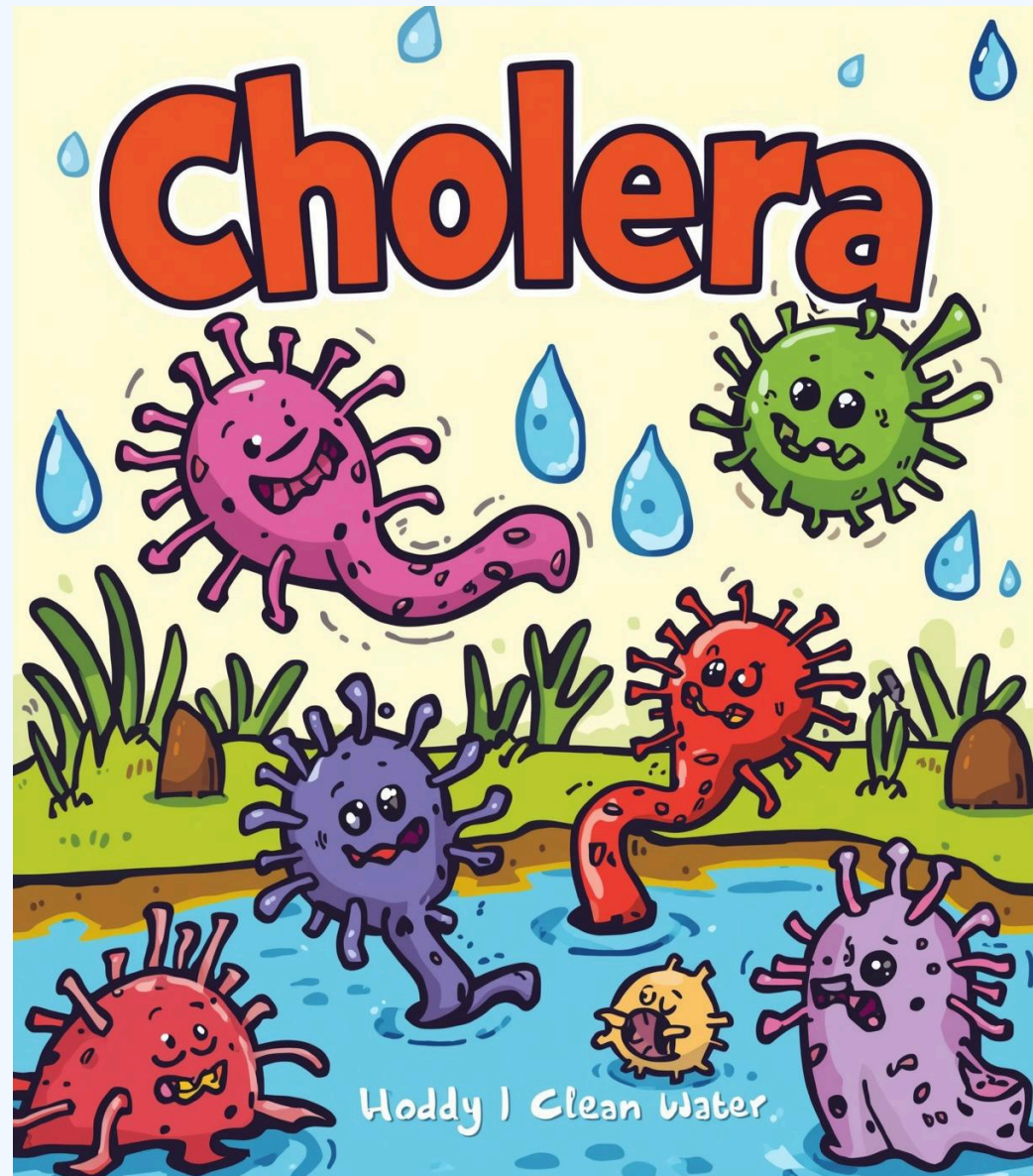
Sanitation prevents disease spread



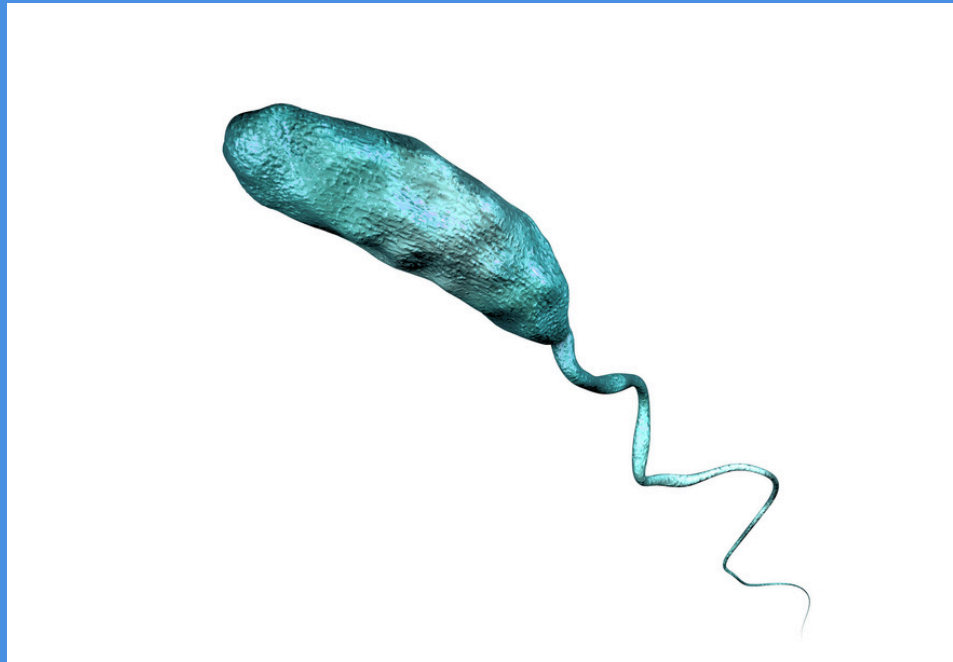

What is Cholera?

Cholera is caused by bacteria in water.



Spread



- Cholera spreads through **contaminated water**.
- Poor sanitation leads to outbreaks.
- Germs can travel via **hands** and **food**.
- Lack of clean water increases risk.
- Vaccines help prevent cholera illness.



Key Strategies for Preventing Disease



Vaccines

Protects against diseases like cholera effectively.



Sanitation

Clean facilities prevent germs from spreading quickly.



Clean Water

Access to safe water saves lives and health.



Education

Teaching hygiene helps everyone stay healthy together.
