INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) State your selected topic for your community narrative. You should include a possible title for your podcast episode or textual narrative.

- 2) Explain why specifically this topic is interesting to you and is important for people to hear about.

- 3) Present the background information you found that is relevant to your topic and that will inform the conversation you have with your interviewee. This section should be from 200 - 250 words. You can write it in full paragraphs or you can use a bullet point list. Include citations for at least three sources you found. This can be what you found through online/library research, and encompass sources such as family members and community leaders.

- 4) List five questions that you will use for your interview(s).
